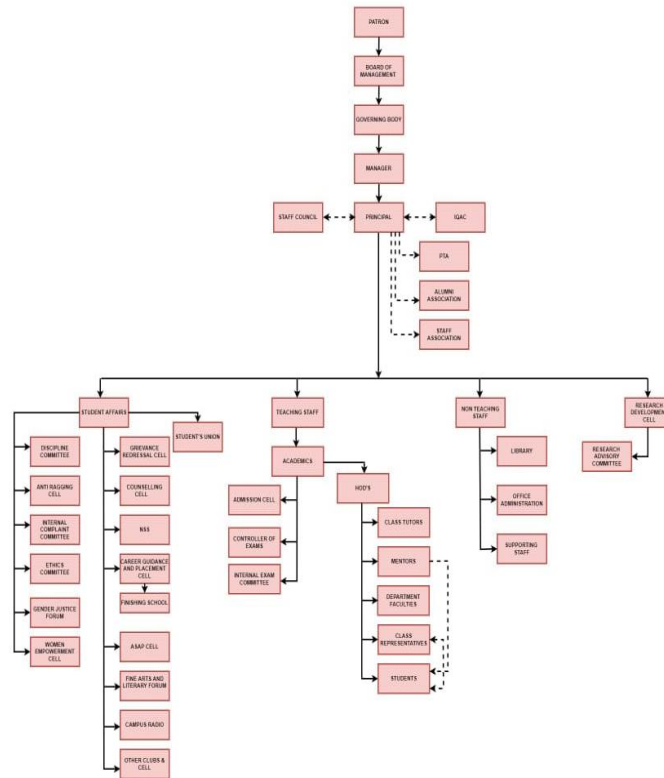

The regular undergraduate courses following Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) and post-graduate courses based on the Credit Semester System (CSS), a combination of internal and external evaluation with grading.
